- 2. Abstract should be submitted in English; Title typed in bold & sentence case format
- 3. Provide complete author name(s), contact address(s), number & email. Underline the name of person making presentation.
- 4. Make sure that the body of the abstract is written as one paragraph, and not to exceed 300 words (title, names, and affiliations are not included into 300 words)
- 5. Font: Times New Roman 12pt for English.
- 6. Please write on the top of the abstract the type of presentation (Poster or Oral), and one or two of the conference objectives/Theme (1 to 8)

Nomination of "Society Fellow Member" and Award

Nomination for the "Society Fellow Member" Award: Any society member may nominate themselves or other members by submitting a request to the Organizing Secretary of BIOCICON 2025. The winner of the "Society Fellow Member" award is granted: A certificate and A special plate. The criteria for evaluating a candidacy for the "Society Fellow Member" award in the Indian Academy of Biopesticides (InABP) are as follows:

- 1. Should be a member of Indian Academy of Biopesticides [https://www.inabp.org/membership-forms.php]
- 2. Contribution to the biopesticides sector, publications (journals, newsletters, books, etc.), and ongoing participation in prior BIOCICONs.
- 3. Membership in Professional Committees or Councils established by Entomological, Plant Pathological, or Eco-friendly Pest Management associations or organizations.
- 4. Coordinating scientific conferences and agricultural gatherings.

 Scientific advancements in the domain of Eco-Friendly Plant Protection and Production and additional accomplishments, if applicable.

Awards/Recognition: Each session will have awards for the Best Paper presentations. Additionally, there are awards for Best Teachers, Senior Scientists, Best Ph.D. Theses, Best Eco-friendly Product Manufacturer, Best Biopesticide Dissertation (UG Project, PG Thesis), Young Professional (for recently joined faculty with 5 years' experience), and Lifetime Achievement Awards (to be determined by the Executive Board). Students, Scholars, Faculty/Scientist and Entrepreneurs [Business people] have to pay processing fees of Rs. 250, 500, 1000, and 5000, respectively.

Awards for Best 3 photos in Plant Protection: Awards will be conferred for the three best images. The winner will be awarded a certificate. The image must illustrate a pest, a natural enemy, or indicators of insects, microbes and weeds. The A4 photograph must be original, high-resolution, and taken by the candidate for the award. The participant is permitted to submit up to 3 photos. The photos must illustrate key components of economically relevant pests in the applicant's region or country.
